LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT:

At this time we have one show scheduled for May 1 & 2 at Arden in the lower arena. This will be a 2 day, double judged show and South Carolina will be helping us with this show. In return, North Carolina will help South Carolina with their show June 12 & 13. It will be mandatory for you to show at both shows to all judges in order to qualify for our year end awards. We will be counting the points from SC's other show on October 9 & 10 and from the Southern Gold Group show on Labor Day weekend in Unadilla, Georgia.

The final points for 2009 are included in this newsletter along with the award winners. Remember that in order to qualify for any year-end award for 2009, the horse/exhibitor must have shown at both of the shows sponsored by NCPEA. All the shows in NC, SC, VA and the SGG show count toward year-end awards but if you or the horse did not show at both NCPEA shows then you will not qualify for year end awards. In addition, it takes a minimum of 15 points in the youth and 20 points in a division in open/amt to qualify for an award. The awards banquet will be held on March 6, 2010 at my house in Asheboro. We have tried many different avenues for this banquet over the years and last year this seemed to be a very relaxed and enjoyable evening for those who attended. I do hope that each one of you will make plans to come, relax and enjoy an evening with friends whether you are receiving an award or not. I do not have the particulars for the menu at this time but as you will see on the sign up sheet we are attempting to make this a very affordable event for everyone to attend.

In closing I want to thank my board of directors for all the hard work and time they have put in. We have met many challenges again this year and persevered through them all. I would like to thank each and every member for all the help you have given at the shows and for encouragement that you gave to me and the board throughout the year.
