## **Palomino and Palomino Bred**

- 1. Year End Awards: Must enroll in the NCPEA Golden Year End Award Program Form Location: NCPEA Facebook Files & NCPEA Website
- 2. Circuit Awards (Weekend High Point): All exhibitors are eligible regardless if enrolled in NCPEA Golden Year End Award Program
- 3. Must show to 6 Judges to qualify for Year End Awards
- 4. Must meet the minimum of 20 Points to qualify for Year End Awards
- 5. Must Show in an In Hand Class to qualify for Year End Awards
- 6. Grand and Reserve will count for Year End Awards

## All Breed (AB)

- 1. Year End Awards: Must enroll in the NCPEA Golden Year End Award Program Form Location: NCPEA Facebook Files & NCPEA Website
- 2. Circuit Awards (Weekend High Point): All are eligible regardless if enrolled in NCPEA Golden Year End Award Program
- 3. AB will Show to 2 Judges each show
- 4. Must Show to 4 Judges to qualify for Year End Awards
- 5. Must Meet the Minimum of 20 Points to qualify for Year End Awards
- 6. Conformation Classes will count in the Halter Division
- 7. Must Show in a AB Ranch Riding Class in order to show in Ranch Confirmation Class
- 8. AB Trail is open to English or Western attire and the exhibitor must select the English or Western division for their points
- 9. AB Ranch Trail points count in the Ranch division only
- 10. Exhibitor may show in only ONE trail class per division
  - i.e. AB Trail classes or AB Ranch Trail classes. The exhibitor may choose to show in both AB Trail and AB Ranch Trail, but may only show in ONE class each
  - It is the exhibitor's discretion whether they want to show at 2 gaits (W/J) or 3 gaits (W/J/L) in either section
- 11. AB Showmanship is open to English, Western, or Ranch attire and the points would count in the respective division requested. (Only One)
- 12. AB Reining would not count for any high point award
- 13. Exhibitors may go in walk/trot and walk/trot/canter classes
- 14. Exhibitors may cross enter Western and Ranch Classes
