(Showmanship counts as a Performance Class)

Halter, Halter Youth, Color, PB Halter, PHBA Youth Performance,  
PB Youth Performance, PB Performance, PHBA Open, PHBA  
Amateur Performance, PHBA Ranch, PHBA Ranch Youth, PHBA  
Amateur W/T/J, CHP

#### Qualifications:

Exhibitor/Horse earning the most points in PHBA classes within  
each Division above (regardless of enrollment in NCPEA Golden  
Year End Award Program)
